

## Assessment Vouchers: \$300 off a Comprehensive Energy Assessment

Assessment Vouchers, offered by The County of Los Angeles/Southern California Regional Energy Network (SoCalREN), help Participating Contractors offer a \$300 discount on a Comprehensive Energy Assessment that leads to a completed Energy Upgrade California® Home Upgrade/Advanced Home Upgrade project.



### Requirements

Each Assessment Voucher provides \$300 directly to the Participating Contractor after meeting the following requirements:

- The homeowner must complete a Home Upgrade/Advanced Home Upgrade project in The County of Los Angeles/ SoCalREN, Southern California Edison (SCE) and/or SoCalGas® territory.
- The Participating Contractor must include a line item on the customer invoice indicating “Comprehensive Energy Assessment” to show that an energy assessment has been completed.
- The Participating Contractor must complete an in-home Comprehensive Energy Assessment and provide a report to the homeowner. The in-home Comprehensive Energy Assessment shall be based on building science principles (heavily influenced by BPI standards) and will include:
  - The use of appropriate equipment in diagnosing opportunities for improving energy efficiency and minimizing health and safety hazards.
  - A review with the homeowner/occupant(s), if available, about any concerns they may have related to the performance of their home.
  - Immediate disclosure to homeowner/occupant(s) when any suspected emergency or urgent health and safety hazard or situation is present in the home.
- The Participating Contractor's report will include:
  - Results of diagnostic tests and visual/sensory inspections including a summary of the diagnostic testing and inspections and their purpose.
  - Information on energy programs, incentives, regulations and energy costs relevant to prioritized recommendations for improving the home.
  - A baseline energy use analysis [when energy-consumption records are available].
  - A comprehensive set of recommended health and safety measures, warranted by the site-specific circumstances.
  - A comprehensive set of recommended energy efficiency measures, warranted by the site-specific circumstances.
  - Advice to the homeowner/occupants on user-controlled energy reduction strategies.

### Assessment Voucher Application

To redeem the \$300 Assessment Voucher, please complete and submit the online application with the required supporting documentation (if applicable). Submissions received after the Assessment Voucher expiration date will be invalid and void. Assessment Vouchers are available on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available or until discontinued by The County of Los Angeles/SoCalREN.

### To redeem an Assessment Voucher, Participating Contractors must submit:

- A valid (unexpired) promotional code. Submissions received after the expiration date will be invalid and void.
- For Home Upgrade/Advanced Home Upgrade projects outside of The County of Los Angeles/SoCalREN territory, a copy of the Notice of Incentive Approval email from SCE or SoCalGas, verifying the project is complete. Notice of Incentive Reservation documents is not a valid form of verification; this form does not provide sufficient evidence of a completed project.
- For The County of Los Angeles/SoCalREN Home Upgrade projects, the Home Upgrade project must be completed before redeeming an Assessment Voucher.
- A copy of the customer invoice showing a line item for the "Comprehensive Energy Assessment" showing the \$300 discount to the homeowner.

Both Home Upgrade and Advanced Home Upgrade projects are eligible. In addition, projects submitted to The County of Los Angeles/SoCalREN and ICF are both eligible.

## Limitations and Restrictions

Please note that Assessment Vouchers are available on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available or until discontinued by The County of Los Angeles/SoCalREN. Listed below are the limitations and restrictions that apply to the program:

- Each Home Upgrade/Advanced Home Upgrade project is limited to one Assessment Voucher code.
- Each contractor is limited to a maximum of 20 Assessment Voucher codes (\$6000) until 2017 funds run out or until December 31, 2017, whichever comes first.
- The Home Upgrade/Advanced Upgrade project must be completed before being able to redeem an Assessment Voucher code related to the project.
